


















What we know (or suspect)

- Very easy to propagate
- Remarkably drought tolerant
- Not shade tolerant
- Very hard to cultivate terrestrially
- Does not tolerate 'wet feet' or buried stems

What we don't know (and would like to).

- Why wild seed isn't germinating
- How to get them back into the wild
- How far to go with mixing populations
